Climbers must provide evidence of hardware and rope compatibility (manufacture specifications).

Climbers must check all gear is in date and meets manufactures guidelines. This includes PPE, rope splices (provide evidence splice was done correctly or by an authorised organisation), check harness expiry dates. All gear to be cleaned prior and only check in gear that you anticipate to use throughout the event.

Climbers must present themselves at Gear Check onsite at the event Friday the 13th November no later than 3pm. Novice climbers to present themselves before 9am on Friday 13th November. Please note that the time might change. Climbers should come to the ArbWest marquee.
