 - Maintain relevant insurances:
 - Public Liability Insurance
 - (\$20 million) and/or
 - Professional Indemnity Insurance
 - (\$5 million) and/or
 - Workers Compensation
 - Insurance documentation to be provided annually at renewal
 - Employment of suitably qualified personnel meeting minimum AQF standards (copies provided annually):
 - Certificate III in Arboriculture (or higher)
 - Diploma/Certificate V in Arboriculture (or higher) for consultancy services
 - Safe systems of work that meet the requirements of the WorkSafe checklist as a minimum - see link next page
 - If you are working near power lines you or your teams must hold current ESI2 qualifications
